# What We Do

The mission of the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center is to enrich the cultural, social, and educational life of the community through professionally produced live theatre, concerts, other cultural events and year round educational programs for children and adults. 2014-15 marked our **33rd Anniversary**.

Attendance for all 132 performances this season totaled nearly 33,000 with over 2,200 attending Town Hall Arts Center for the first time this season. Preview performances of each main stage musical were attended by over 1,050 underprivileged individuals served by ArtReach, Above and Beyond, the Colorado Center for the Blind, Libby Bortz Assisted Living and volunteers of the Denver Zoo.

## Awards

Town Hall Arts Center received ten nominations for the 2015 Henry Awards. Most notably Town Hall Arts Center was nominated for **Outstanding Season for a Theatre Company**. In addition, it received a nomination for **Outstanding Production of a Musical** for *Anything Goes* with Nick Sugar as Director and Donna Kolpan Debrececi as Musical Director. Nick Sugar was also nominated for **Outstanding Direction of a Musical** for *Anything Goes*, and Donna Debrececi was nominated for **Outstanding Musical Direction** for *Anything Goes*. Nick Sugar and Kelly Kates were nominated for **Outstanding Choreography** for *Anything Goes*. Tim Howard was nominated for **Outstanding Actor in a Musical** for *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying*. Norrell Moore was nominated for **Outstanding Actress in a Musical** for *Anything Goes*. Town Hall's **Outstanding Costume Design/Small Budget** nominee was Nikki Harrison for *Anything Goes*, and Town Hall's **Outstanding Lighting Design/Small Budget** nominee was Seth Alison for *Young Frankenstein*. Annie Dwyer won **Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Musical** for *Young Frankenstein*.

In addition to the Henry Award nominations and winner, Town Hall Arts Center also received four Marlowe Awards, three True West Awards and was nominated in eight Broadway World categories. In the **Westword Best of Denver 2015**, Town Hall Arts Center was named "**Best Big Musicals at Small Prices**." Nick Sugar was named for **Best Direction of a Musical** for *Next to Normal*, and Margie Lamb was named for **Best Actress in a Musical** for *Next to Normal*.

# *What We Do*

## **Town Hall Children's Programming**

Some 1,320 persons attended 8 summer camp performances of *Legally Blonde Jr.* Another 1,386 adults and children attended our eight holiday performances of *A Participation Christmas Carol*. We also held multiple sessions of our **Actor's Playground** – children's theater workshop classes for ages 5 - 18 (6 summer sessions, 5 fall sessions, 5 winter/spring sessions) that served 230 students.

Our outreach program, **Arts on the Move**, took 52 performances and workshops to schools, day care centers, and other venues, reaching over 3,700 participants who could not have experienced our children's theatre activities otherwise.

## **Stanton Art Gallery**

The following local artists exhibited in our first floor Stanton Art Gallery during 2014-15 in seven shows: Western Heritage Art featured artists Robert Gray and Sarah Phippen. The Art of Cityscapes featured artists Susan Fraley, Elayne Moseley, and Alan Zeigel. The Art of Water featured artists Collette Brooks, Kay Juricek, Joanne Sisun and Kate Wyman. The Art of Color featured artists Sandra Galloway, M. Leake, Delores Peterson and Molly Squibb. The Art of Focus featured artists Jean Caggiano, Ugljesa Janjic, Sherry Sherman and Jam F. Wong. The Art of Memories featured artists R. Garriott, Helen Matthews, Molly Squibb and Kay Juricek. The final show of the season was I See Two Faces featuring artist Don Hartman.

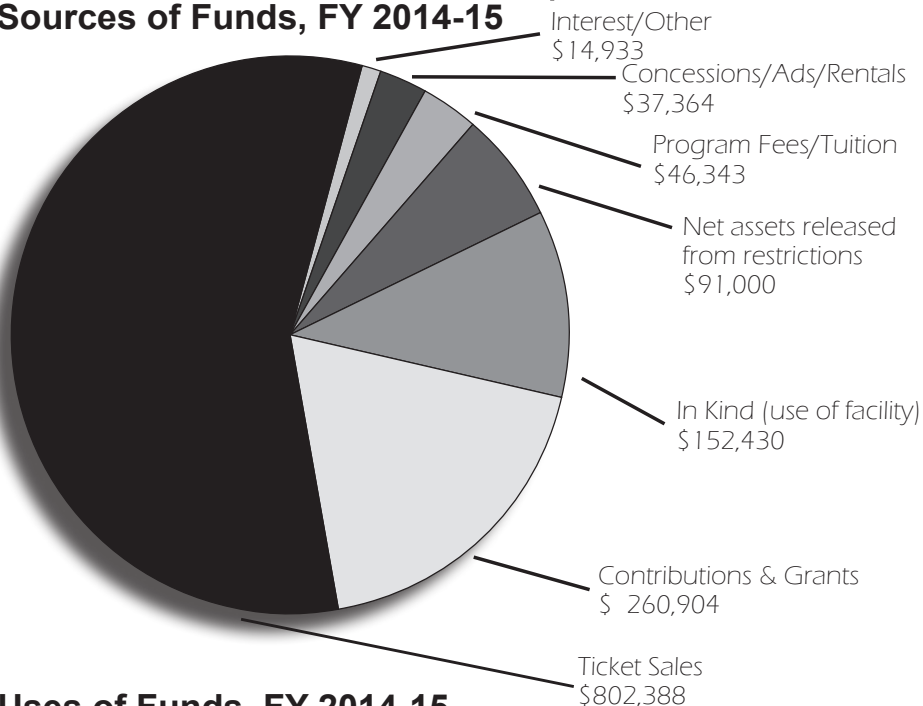

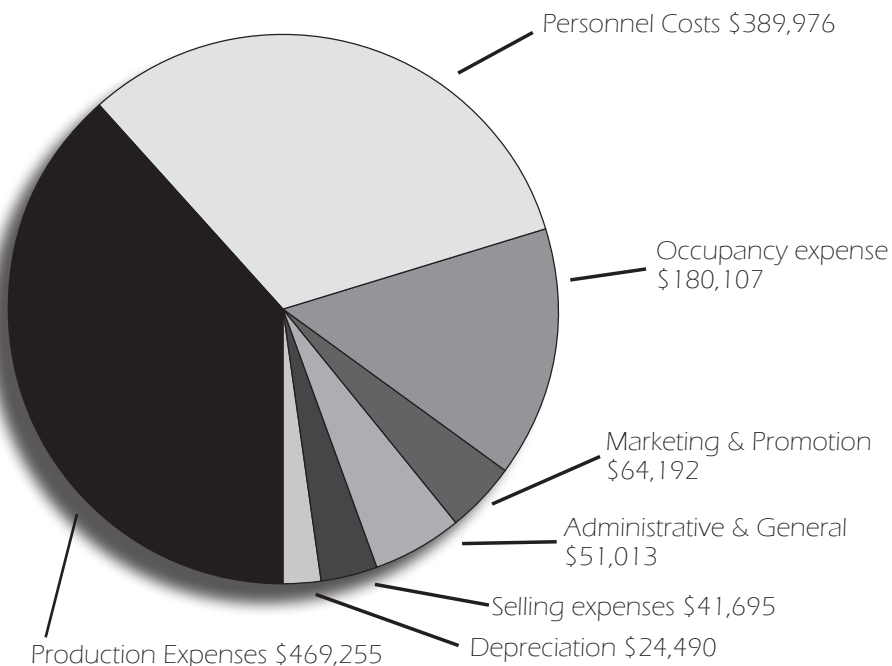
