



What We Do

The mission of the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center is to enrich the cultural, social, and educational life of the community through other professionally produced live theatre, concerts. cultural events and year-round educational programs for children and adults. 2018-19 marked our 37th Anniversary.

Attendance for all 130 performances this season totaled over 30,000 - 2900 of whom attended Town Hall Arts Center for the first time. Preview performances of each Main Stage production attended were over 1,100 underprivileged individuals served by ArtReach. Above the Colorado Center Blind. and Beyond, for the Libby Bortz Assisted Living, Meals on Wheels, Shiloh House, and volunteers of the Denver Zoo.

Town Hall Arts Center received a nomination for the 2019 Henry Awards. Maggie Lamb was nominated for Outstanding Supporting Actress for *Sister Act.* Town Hall was also voted one of the Best Theatres in the Denver area and #3 Best Theatre Group by Denver's A List - a listing of close to 10K businesses competing for best titles.

What We Do

Stanton Art Gallery



The Stanton Gallery was made possible through the generous gift of Charles E. Stanton in 1983. During the 2018-2019 season, over 25 local artists were featured in seven exhibits. The art exhibits were rotated in conjunction with each of the six Main Stage productions, while the seventh exhibit featured western art for the 91st annual Western Welcome Week. The Gallery is free and open to the public during the week from 10am-5pm, and during all performances.

Town Hall's Educational Programming

In the summer of 2019, over 950 people attended eight summer camp performances of the younger teens' production of *Mary Poppins*. Another 250 attended two performances of the second camp production of *Lear*, geared to older students. An additional 265 persons attended our youngsters' two performances of **Krazy Kamp**, while another 850 adults and children attended our eight holiday performances of *A Participation Christmas Carol*. The total audience for our youth performances in 2018-19 was 3,260.

We also held multiple sessions of our **Actor's Playground** -- children's theater workshop classes for ages 5 - 18 (8 summer sessions, 5 fall sessions, 6 winter/spring sessions) that served 345 students. Town Hall Arts Center's Mark Stahlman Memorial Classes for students with disabilities and special needs served 60 students during 2018-2019.

Our outreach program, **Arts on the Move**, took 65 performances and workshops to schools, day care centers, and other venues, as well as at home here at Town Hall Arts Center. That program reached over 4,500 participants who could not have experienced our children's theatre activities otherwise.


